A few words from a member of your Ministry Team:

Ordination is a lifelong calling for an individual, as they follow the lead of God's Spirit.

It marks a transition in ministry and service.

Although a personal calling. It requires a community to belong to, to serve, and to lead.

In the Church of England, Clergy (vicars, rectors, priests, to name just a few other terms meaning the same thing) are ordained twice.

Initially they are ordained Deacon, a servant, which they remain for the rest of their lives. At the heart of this is service, both to God, and for God. It is lived out to and with others in community. It involves being set apart and available and is rooted in prayer.

Then a year later for those called to priestly duties, they are ordained Priest.

Having been ordained deacon last year, Jason is priested this year on 5th July.

Differences between the two can be seen in active duties undertaken within church life and the life of the wider community. These are known as sacraments and include presiding at Holy Communion (the Lord's Supper, Eucharist), Marriage ceremonies, and offering Blessing and Absolution to name just a few.

Ordination is a powerful and personal experience that is also deeply rooted in community and faith. It is a significant event in the life of an individual, of God's call placed on their lives. But it is also significant to the church community to which they belong.
